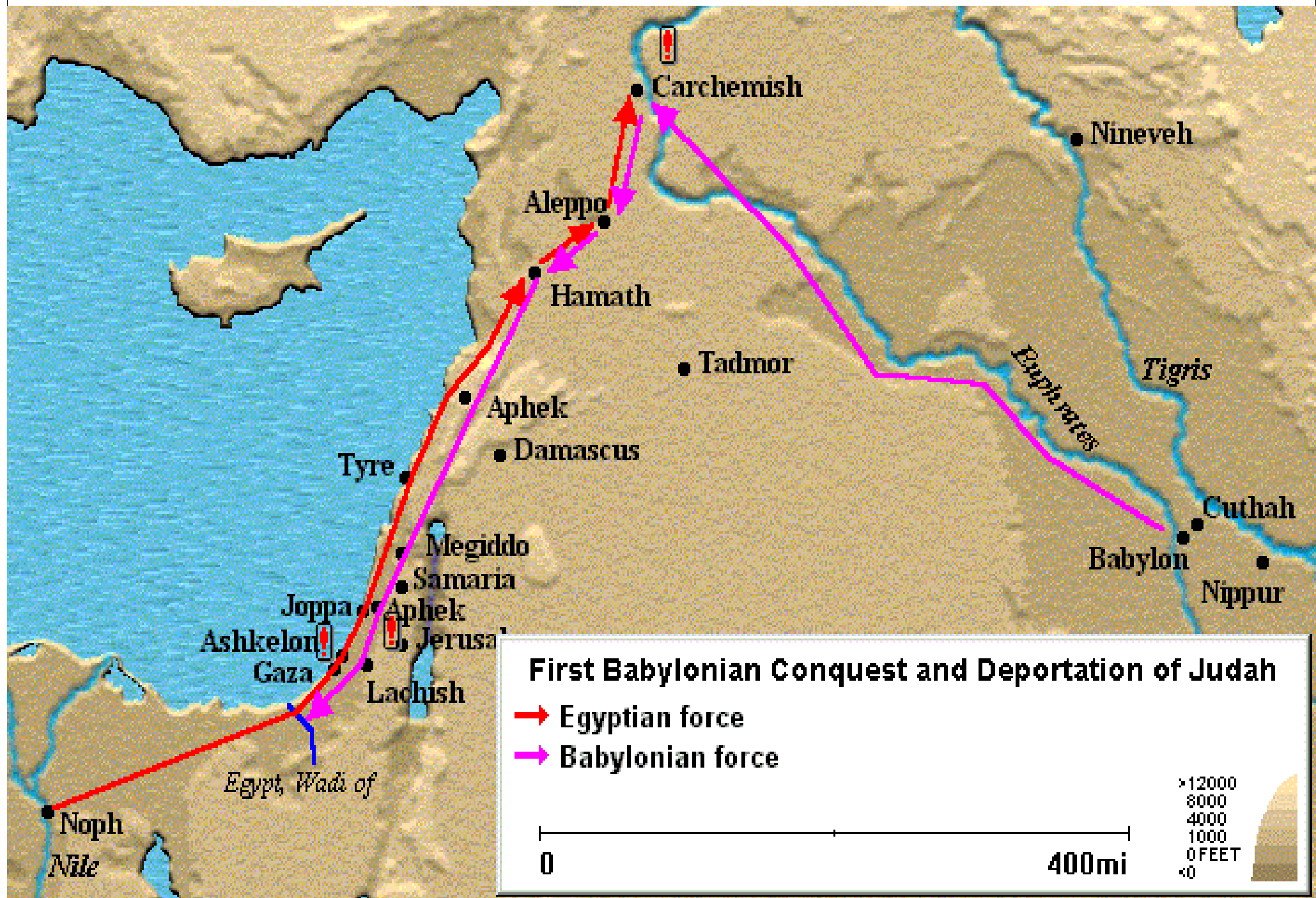
<sup>9</sup> He set fire to the temple of the Lord, the royal palace and all the houses of Jerusalem. Every important building he burned down.

<sup>10</sup> The whole Babylonian army under the commander of the imperial guard broke down the walls around Jerusalem.

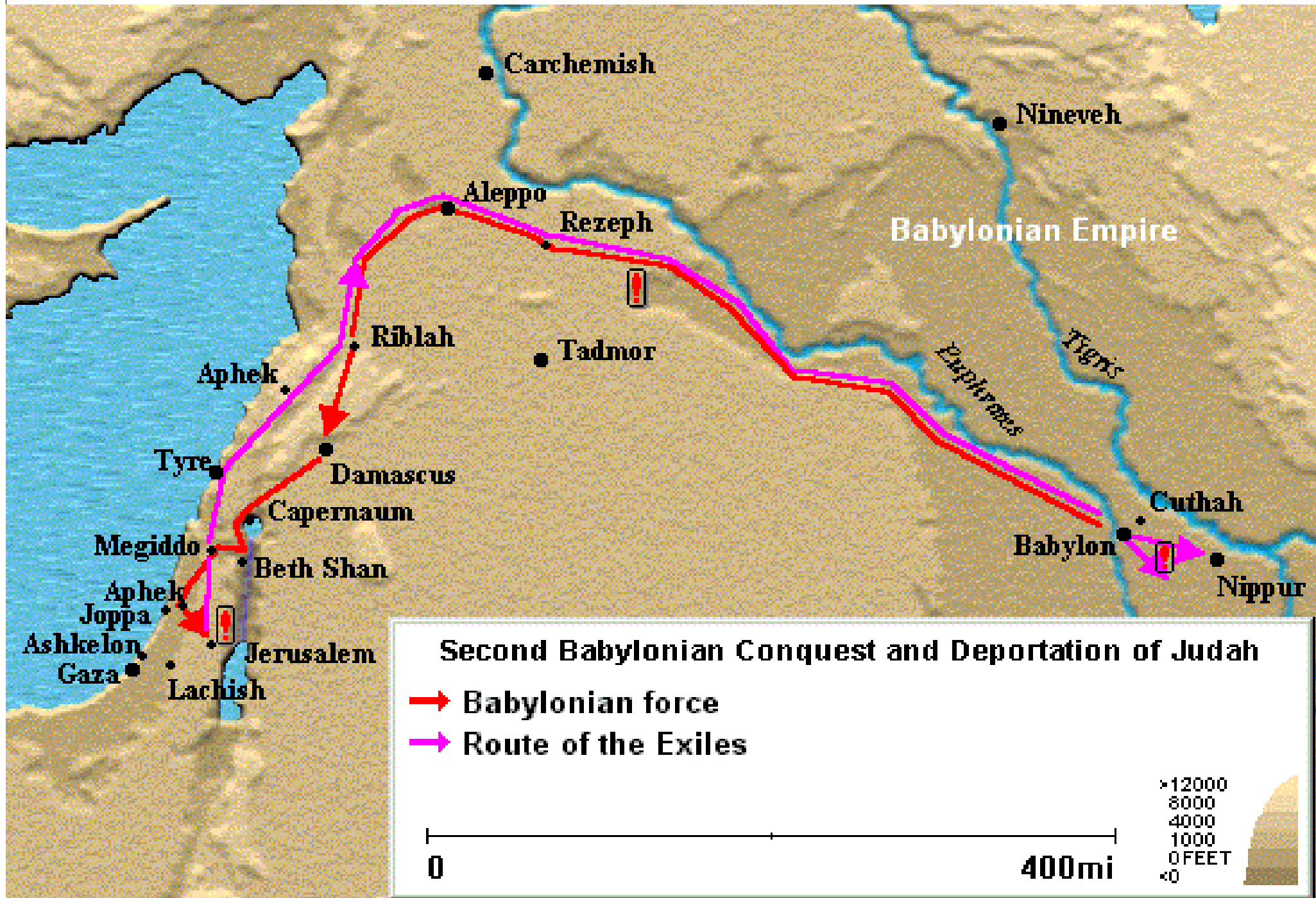
<sup>11</sup> Nebuzaradan the commander of the guard carried into exile the people who remained in the city, along with the rest of the populace and those who had deserted to the king of Babylon.

<sup>12</sup> But the commander left behind some of the poorest people of the land to work the vineyards and fields.

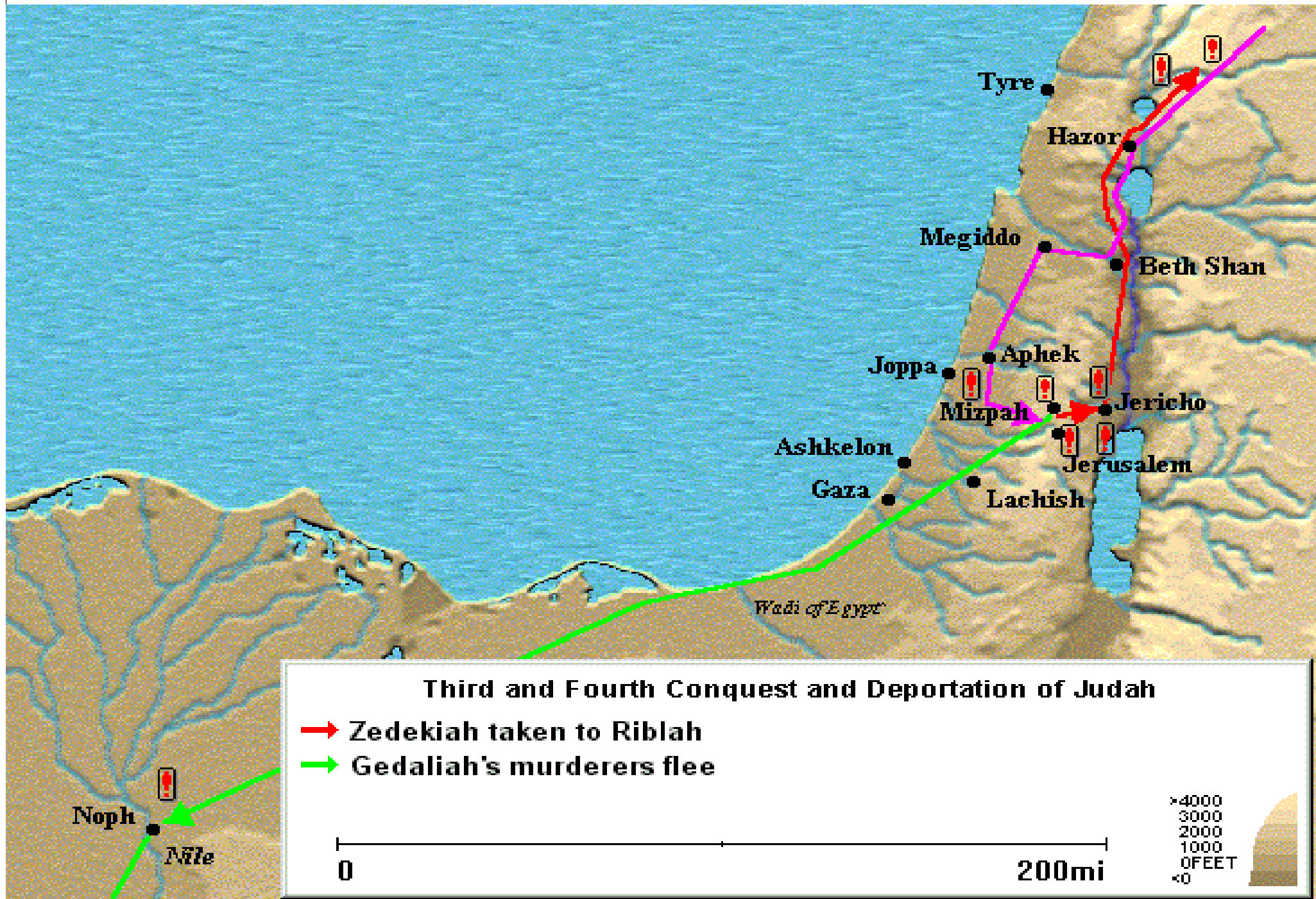
# FIRST BABYLONIAN CONQUEST [605 B.C.]

### 9. KINGDOM

- Kingdom Divided

- Prophets were active during this period and majority of their letters were written during this period
- Messages of Warning about coming judgement from Assyria or Babylon as well as the future worldwide judgment of all nations
- Message of Comfort – related to the return of the nation from exile as well as the coming of the Messiah, and his death for the sins of all people and his future everlasting kingdom which includes peoples of all nations

Isaiah 1:1 “The vision concerning Judah and Jerusalem that Isaiah son of Amoz saw during the reigns of Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz and Hezekiah, kings of Judah”

Amos 1:1 “The words of Amos, one of the shepherds of Tekoa – the vision he saw concerning Israel two years before the earthquake...”
